

Katy First Outdoor Campus Reservation Policy

7/1/2020

Requirements:

- Social distancing of 6' and masks required.
- No singing or person to person contact.
- No indoor facilities can be used including restrooms.
- Food items are allowed individually. There may be no sharing of food, drink, or paper items.
- Surface touchpoints for tents, gazebo, and fencing will need to be sanitized after each use.
- Persons who reserve the space will be responsible for:
 - Each person is required to be temperature scanned. A temperature scanner will be provided.
 - A registration of each participant must be taken upon entry. This registration must be returned the same day as the event.
 - Email a photo of this registration to Laurie at both <u>lleger@katyfirst.org</u> and receptionist@katyfirst.org
 - Each person within the group follows all outdoor campus policies listed.
 - Groups will be responsible to disinfect all surface touchpoints including but not limited to tents, gazebo, and entry/exit of the fence. A bottle of spray disinfectant will be provided.

Time Slots for pumpkin patch reservation:

- Sunday Thursday
 - o 7 AM 10 AM
 - o 5 PM 8:30 PM
- 1-hour limit on reservation

Occupancy for reservation of outdoor usage of the pumpkin patch:

- 30 – social distancing required

Additional notes:

- Playground equipment will not be permitted for use, as of 7/1/2020.
- Additional masks will be on hand for those who did not bring their own mask.
- This same policy may be used for events organized by the staff of Katy First utilizing parking lots or the green space between the Sanctuary and Education building on 5th Street. Occupancy will be determined using social distance measures.
